1) MEETING DECLARED OPEN AND ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

The agenda was adopted as written

2) FENELON MINE PROJECT BY WALLBRIDGE MINING COMPANY LIMITED

- Preliminary information and application for exemption
- For decision on whether the project can be exempted from the assessment process, or recommendation on the scope of the impact assessment

The COMEV received the preliminary information on this project on December 14, 2016, and an application for exemption for the dewatering of the mine installations on January 31, 2017.

The project involves the underground mining, using a 100 m depth ramp, of 97,600 tonnes of gold ore at a rate of 300 metric tonnes per day. The ore will not be processed on-site, but will be trucked to a plant in Abitibi. The proponent intends to ship the ore to the Camflo mill at Richmont Mines in Malartic. The life of the mine is estimated to be between 9 and 12 months.

The application for exemption involves exploration work to extend the life of the mine by carrying out preparatory work such as expansion of the polishing pond, pit dewatering, rehabilitation of pit slopes as well as the ramp, etc.

After reviewing the information submitted by the proponent, the COMEV will forward to the Provincial Administrator its recommendation on the scope of the environmental and social impact assessment to be conducted by the proponent, with emphasis on aspects such as project description, water quality, woodland caribou and consultation with land users. The proponent's two applications (operation and dewatering of the pit) should be treated as one project by the proponent.

Action: Send a letter to the Provincial Administrator advising her to forward the impact assessment directive for the Fenelon mine project.

3) OPERATION OF A QUARRY OF LESS THAT THREE HECTARES AT KM 298 OF THE ROUTE DU NORD BY THE SOCIÉTÉ D'ÉNERGIE DE LA BAIE-JAMES

- a) Preliminary information
 - For recommendation on whether the project can be exempted from the assessment process

The Société d'énergie de la Baie-James (SEBJ) sent the preliminary information on this project to the COMEV on December 21, 2016.

The SEBJ plans to operate a quarry of less than three hectares on Category III lands to repair the airstrip at Nemiscau Airfield. The quarry is slated to open in 2017. \

After reviewing the information on this project, the COMEV recommends that it can be exempted from the environmental and social impacts assessment procedure.

Action: Send a letter to the Provinical Administrator recommending that the project be exempted.

4) VARIA

The COMEV has been informed that it will soon receive an application for exemption for a proposed loading dock at Chibougamau. The project would involve the clearing of some land and the addition of a section of railway track to allow for the loading of train cars. The COMEV will therefore have to study this project in the near future.
