4) Project development and operation of the Fenelon mine by Wallbridge Mining Company Limited

Preliminary information

• For recommendation on whether to exempt the project from the assessment process or on the scope of the impact study to be conducted

The Evaluating Committee (COMEV) received the preliminary information on the above project by Wallbridge Mining Company Limited on June 10, 2019.

In this project, Wallbridge Mining Company Limited would like to develop a high grade gold deposit by sinking two deep shafts to the mineralized zone from the existing portal and shafts. The plan is to transport the mined ore to an ore processing plant in the region for gold production by custom milling.

Members reviewed a draft directive and made some modifications to the text before agreeing that the directive will be sent to the Provincial Administrator.

Action: Forward the impact study directive to the Provincial Administrator.

The Evaluating Committee (COMEV) received the preliminary information on the above project on February 11, 2019 and additional information on March 13, 2019. Responses to the committee's questions and comments, sent in April of 2019, were received on May 30. Finally, the responses in connection to the follow-up of the application for exemption were received on September 5, 2019.

According to this proposal, Balmoral Resources Ltd. wants to build a permanent camp with a capacity for 162 people, replacing the existing temporary camp that has a capacity of 80 people. Increasing the capacity will require the modification of existing infrastructure, which will be carried out in two phases: the upgrade to standards of the sanitary wastewater treatment facilities for 80 people and then the expansion of the camp to house 162 workers, including the modification of the wastewater treatment system and the drinking water distribution system.

After studying the documents sent by the proponent, the COMEV decided to recommend that the project be exempted from the review process.

However, the COMEV would like to point out that the exemption of this project should not interfere with the social and environmental impacts assessment and review process initiated as part of the Fenelon gold mine project.

Action: Send letter to Provincial Administrator recommending the project be exempted from review process.
