### 4) Champion Lake shoreline protection project by the Cree Nation of Nemaska Ref. No.: 3019-01-002

- Preliminary information
  - For recommendation on whether to exempt the project from the review procedure, or on the scope of the impact study to be conducted

On July 23, 2021, the Evaluating Committee (COMEV) received the preliminary information regarding a project by the Cree First Nation of Nemaska to protect the shoreline of Champion Lake.

The proponent would like to halt erosion along the shoreline of Lake Cahmpion bordering the community of Nemaska in order to protect existing and future infrastructure, ensure the long-term safety of users, and improve the natural beauty the surrounding area. The plan is to install a rock-filled protective embankment on two sections of the shoreline to stabilize the slopes in the most heavily eroded areas. Approximately half of the proposed construction and labour will take place on Category I land, and the other half on Category II land.

After reviewing the documents sent by the proponent, COMEV members agreed that they require additional information before continuing their analysis. The proponent, therefore, must answer questions and comments, to be included in the letter, transmitted by the Committee. The Committee also agreed to inform the Provincial Administrator that activities connected to the construction and operation phases of the project will take place on Category II lands, and to send him a copy of the correspondence.
