On November 26, 2019, the Evaluating Committee (COMEV) received the preliminary information regarding the above project. Additional information was received November 5, 2020 and April 29 and October 26, 2021.

For this project, Bonterra Resources plans to carry out underground explorations of the gold deposit near and beneath Barry Lake. The plans also call for construction of a gate and a 30 meters wide underground access ramp, as well as a service building, a garage, a well for industrial water, service areas and a parking lot. In addition, they plan to build a storage area for organic matter, an overburden pile, a waste rock pile, and two ponds for water management.

The COMEV understands that the proponent has agreed to undertake a characterization study of the wetlands and water bodies in the surrounding area when the proponent applies for the ministerial authorization under Section 22 of the EQA. Moreover, if the MELCC asks the proponent to move certain infrastructures after the application for authorization, the proponent realizes that he will have to submit a new request for an attestation of exemption.

If Resources Bonterra intends to submit a new application for an attestation of exemption, the COMEV will also ask the proponent to submit a summary of the various existing commitments.

After reviewing the documents provided by the proponent, the COMEV agree to recommend that this project be exempted from the environmental and social impact assessment procedure.
