1) Meeting 311 declared open and adoption of the agenda

The agenda was adopted as written.

2) Adoption of the minutes of the 310th meeting

4) Mining project for the construction and operation of a gold-copper deposit in the Eeyou Istchee James Bay territory by Troilus Gold

Before the Evaluating Committee (COMEV) can issue an impact study directive for this project, it needs to verify certain information regarding the identification and delimitation of natural areas, undisturbed areas, restored areas, and disturbed areas (in the exploration and future exploitation phases) located on the project site. The COMEV is also awaiting additional details to clarify certain aspects of the project. The project analysis will continue during the meeting scheduled for August 11, 2022.

5) Creation of Assinica National Park by the Ministère des Forêts, de la Faune et des Parcs (MFFP)

> Update of the impact study directive

In July of 2012, the Ministère du Développement durable, de l'Environnement, de la Faune et des Parcs sent the preliminary information for the Assinica National Park project. Following an analysis of the project, in October of 2012 the Evaluating Committee (COMEV) sent the proponent a directive setting out the parameters of the impact study. Because the 2012 directive was valid for only three (3) years, the proponent has asked for it to be updated.

The COMEV received on June 2, 2022, the request for an updated version of the impact study directive for the Assinica National Park project.

The Assinica Park project responds to a commitment in the "Peace of the Braves," an agreement reached between the Government of Quebec and the Cree Nation in February of 2004. This commitment aims, in part, to protect a portion of the Cree heritage lands of Assinica by granting it the status of a National Park of Quebec. This park will protect a representative sample of the boreal forest and natural regions of the Rupert Plateau and James Bay Lowlands.

At each stage of this project, the National Parks Department of the MFFP has consulted with the stakeholders, including the tallymen, affected by the project. This process led to longer than expected delays and, consequently, the impact study has not yet been conducted.

After reviewing the documents transmitted by the proponent, the COMEV recommended that an update of the directive be sent, along with its letter of transmittal, to the Provincial Administrator.

6) Environmental rehabilitation of a former gas/service station in the Radisson area by the Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles

The Evaluating Committee (COMEV) received the preliminary information on the above project on May 24, 2022.

The Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles (MERN) wishes to clean-up and decontaminate the soil at a former gas/service station located on the outskirts of the town of Radisson. The site has been abandoned since the dismantling of the fuel infrastructure. The soil decontamination will be done on-site by biodegradation to meet criterion C of the Intervention Guide - *Guide d'intervention: Protection des sols et réhabilitation des terrains contaminés*. At the end of the soil treatment, the site will be backfilled with decontaminated soil and leveled.

After reviewing the documents from the proponent, COMEV members agreed that this project should be exempted from the social and environmental impacts assessment process.

The COMEV will remind the proponent that it will have to file a rehabilitation plan with the MELCC's Regional Analysis and Expertise branch for Abitibi-Témiscamingue and Nord-du-Québec. In addition, the COMEV will encourage the proponent to set the soil decontamination objective to meet criterion A or Bécotox of the *Guide d'intervention - Protection des sols et réhabilitation des terrains contaminés* to maximize the ecological potential of the project.

Action: Send a letter to the Provincial Administrator Recommendation of exemption

7) Environmental rehabilitation of a former service station on the Trans-Taïga Road by the Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles

10) Meeting 311 B – August 11, 2022: Mining project for the construction and operation of a copper-gold deposit in the Eeyou Istchee James Bay territory by Troilus Gold Ref. No.: 3214-11-025

Project Notice - Preliminary information

For recommendation on whether to exempt the project from the review process, or on the scope of the impact study to be conducted

The Evaluating Committee (COMEV) received the preliminary information on the above project on June 6, 2022.

The aim of this project is the reopening of the old Troilus gold and copper mine located about 175 km north of Chibougamau in the Nord-du-Québec region. The project site is on Category III lands of the Cree community of Mistissini. Troilus plans to extract ore from three open pits: two pits that were previously mined and are currently in the restoration process (J4 and 87) will be enlarged, and a new pit will be created in the southwest zone of the project (South-West pit).

After reviewing all the information from the proponent, the COMEV agreed to transmit to the Provincial Administrator, in the form of an attachment to a letter of transmittal, a directive outlining the recommended scope of the social and environmental impact study to be conducted by the proponent.

The Evaluating Committee (COMEV) received the preliminary information on the above project on May 25, 2022.

In this project, the Ministère de l'Énergie et des Ressources naturelles (MERN) wishes to clean and decontaminate the soil at a former service station located on the Trans-Taïga road. The petroleum infrastructure was removed in 2020 and the site is vacant. Contaminated soils will be removed for off-site treatment or will be sent to a landfill and/or soil treatment site, depending on their level of contamination. The site will be backfilled with clean soil from a regional borrow pit.

After reviewing the documents from the proponent, COMEV members agreed they need further information to continue their analysis. Questions and comments will be forwarded to the proponent for response.
